- 3. Seek godly counsel—Often we try to do things by ourselves and limit good information because we don't include others in our decision-making process. Proverbs 15:22 says, "Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed."
- **Never rush a major decision**—Proverbs 15:28 tells us "The heart of the righteous weighs its answers, but the mouth of the wicked gushes evil." Remember, there are always good, better, and best choices. Don't settle for Good when you can wait for the Best.
- Never make a decision when emotions run high—We cannot think correctly when we are pressured. Breathe and take time to make the best decision.
- 6. **ASK: Will it hinder my Christian walk?** You are a child of the King. Don't compromise your values.
- 7. ASK: How will it effect the rest of my life? My family? Those around me?

These are just a few things to think about when making godly decisions. Study your Bible, talk to others, and especially talk to God about everything. God will never lead us the wrong way. May God bless you richly.


