# Reflection – Hidden Snakes by C.C. Allen

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places." – Ephesians 6:10-12

Laura didn't see the snake, but it was there. It must have come out of its hole when she stomped on the ground. She had moved a paver, on which hundreds of ants were crawling like mad and had made their way to the top of her shoes before she noticed. After stomping them off, she moved to another paver, closer to the hole and kicked it up to check for ants. Unfortunately, a rock caught her foot sending Laura backward into the tree directly behind her. In a split-second, she was on her rear-end staring at a large snake three feet away, slithering like crazy. How could she have missed a snake located so close by?

As our focus scripture indicates, we are all involved in a spiritual battle with invisible forces every day. Just because we don't see Satan, it doesn't mean that he doesn't exist. Our enemy is real, and the conflict he causes is real. This conflict has eternal implications as indicated in 2 Corinthians 10:3-4: "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses." And 1 Peter 5:8 says, "Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." These scriptures call us to consider the root of any struggle or relational conflict we experience. Are they satanically rooted?

Dear Lord, the next time we observe personal, church, or global conflict, help us to consider the source. Is it just us this time, or something outside of us? Please make us acutely aware of Satan's goal to divide us. Help us wear our spiritual armor every day. Thank you for wisdom to know how to pray, to forgive, and strength to avoid the devil's schemes. Amen.
