Reflection: Your Ultimate Victory! By Mark Finn

At each passage of life from youth to old age—graduations, baptisms, weddings, new babies, retirement—we hear the line, "This is not an end, but a beginning." Since a good definition of wisdom is to begin with the end in mind, let's look at the end.

Jesus told us, "Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven.
