Reflection: 30 Days of Thanks: A challenge to thank God & others every day – by Asherita

Right around this time of year, pour Facebook feeds get flooded with updates and photos of things our friends are grateful for. And it's only natural: November is a beautiful reminder to look back on the previous year and recount just how much the Father has given us. But what if we took our thankfulness to the next level? What if we went from simply posting photos of stuff to actually impacting people's lives with our gratitude?

"How can I do that?" you ask. Simple. After thanking God for whatever it is you're grateful for, take 2 seconds and thank the person who made it possible. Because while all good and perfect gifts come from the Father of lights, those blessings usually come through the wonderful people in our lives.
