"Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

1 Thessalonians 5:18

Step 3: Tell someone you appreciate them

Identify a specific person in your life and tell them why you are grateful for them over phone or video chat.

Step 4: Pay it forward

Find a way to show your gratitude to someone in your life by helping them in some small way.

Step 5: Reflect and repeat

Take a few moments to reflect on how your gratitude exercises went and commit to at least one act of gratitude every week.

As we draw closer to Thanksgiving, I encourage you to follow these 5 steps, as well as praying, reading your Bible, and remembering your standing with God.

May your Thanksgiving be full of hope, encouragement, and most of all gratitude to our Heavenly Father.
