# **Reflection:** Take Courage by Domingo Reyes

"Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all you who hope in the Lord!" Psalm 31:24 2020 has been an extremely challenging year. We have battled the Covid-19 pandemic, economic challenges, political division, and even trepidation about murder hornets. We are definitely ready to turn the page and enter 2021! However, many of the problems we faced in 2020 will still be with us in the new year. While this may cause us a little angst, as Christians, we can have hope knowing that God is with us. Take courage from something King David wrote in Psalm 56:3-4, "When I am afraid, I will trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me?" Notice the scripture highlights David's fears. King David was not some sort of superman! He was a mortal man that exhibited anxiety as he faced immense challenges. In other words, he was jut like you and I. Fear is normal. However, David put his fears behind him and operated in faith. He did this by looking to God and realizing that He is more powerful than whatever it is that threatens us.

"Christian" (who is traveling on that path toward the City) grows increasingly fearful but slowly presses on. As he gets closer to the lions, he discovers that only their growls can reach him. God has the lions chained, and "Christian" passes between them unharmed! Faith has many enemies, and one of the greatest is fear.

While the events of 2020 have certainly challenged us, let us move forward into 2021 while looking upward. God is with us! God loves, provides for, cares, protects, heals, delivers, and saves His children. Friends, God is faithful!

I pray that 2021 will be a year we grow to trust God and further expand our faith. Happy New Year!
