Lord, Open Our Eyes by Raymond Sieg

In Matthew 20:30-34 we read: "And, behold, two blind men sitting by the wayside, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, 'Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David!' And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, 'Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David!' And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, 'What will ye that I shall do unto you?' They say unto Him, 'Lord, that our eyes may be opened.' So Jesus had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him."

According to Luke 4:18, one of the reasons why Jesus came to earth was to give "recovering of sight to the blind." On several occasions Jesus demonstrated His divine power by opening the eyes of people afflicted by blindness. On one occasion He even gave sight to a man who was born blind (John 9:1-7).

While we certainly appreciate the Lord's miraculous power to open the eyes of the blind, we need to ask Him to open our eyes so we can see things of spiritual importance. He will help us if we will trust Him and cooperate with Him. Let us consider the following and ask the Lord to open our eyes so we can see that each day is a special blessing from above and that we have reason to rejoice and be glad (Psalm 118:24).

Lord, open our eyes so we can see opportunities to do good that are presented to us (Galatians 6:10).

Lord, open our eyes so we can see the influence we can have upon others by doing good works (Matthew 5:14-16).

Lord, open our eyes so we can see the value of speaking the right words in the right way at the right time (Proverbs 25:11).

Lord, open our eyes so we can look past this life and see eternal things that are not visible to the physical eye (2 Corinthians 4:18).

Lord, open our eyes so we will look in the right direction and "run with patience the race that is set before us" (Hebrews 12:1-2).
