Amazing Jesus from House-to-House newsletter

Everywhere Jesus went, men marveled at His greatness:

- When He was just an infant, Mary and Joseph marveled at what was spoken of Him (Luke 2:33).
- At age 12 many were amazed at Him as He discussed questions with teachers in the temple (Luke 2:46-47).
- His hometown synagogue wondered at His gracious words (Luke 4:22).
- The Jews marveled that He knew letters, having never learned (John 7:15).
- The disciples were amazed at His transfiguration (<u>Mark 9:1-15</u>). They were amazed and marveled at His power to do miracles (<u>Matthew 12:22-23</u>, John 7:21).
- The "multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel" (<u>Matthew 15:31</u>).
- His disciples marveled that His word could wither a living fig tree (<u>Matthew 21:20</u>), that He talked with a Samaritan woman (<u>John 4:27</u>), and that He controlled nature: "What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey Him!" (<u>Matthew 8:27</u>).
- His followers were amazed at His teachings (<u>Mark 1:27</u>) and wondered at His resurrected body (<u>Luke 24:39-41</u>).
- His enemies marveled (<u>Matthew 22:22</u>).
- Governor Pilate marveled at His restraint (<u>Matthew 27:14</u>).
- His executioner marveled at His greatness (Luke 23:47).
