'Forever in Our Hearts'




For 27 years and 10 months, Kenyatta dedicated his life to being a loving hus-


Father and Dear Ole

world. Kenyatta relished in the joy of being a 'Boy Grandfather' to his 'little fellas.'










Author, Man of God, Servant of the Lord


YouTube page; another teaching platform which he created. He attended Potters House Church of Denver where he volunteered in the Food Bank. He also sion. As he was dedicated to his family,

Kenyatta was a decorated athlete having participated in Football and Track & Field for John Dickinson High School, earning varsity letters, medals




