Seven Ups

1. WAKE UP – Decide to have a good day. "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he..." (Proverbs 23:7); "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again, I will say, Rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4)

2. DRESS UP – The best way to dress up is to put on a smile. A smile is an inexpensive way to improve your looks. "The Lord does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." (1 Sam. 16:7).

6. **REACH UP** – For something higher. As Jiminy Cricket sings "High Hopes," always try to better yourself. "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need" (Heb. 4:16).

7. LIFT UP – Your prayers. "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God" (Phil. 4:6).
