Next Sunday we will be collecting names of men you believe are qualified to serve as elders or deacons. Elders and Deacons play a crucial role in the health of a congregation as they serve as church leaders. While today's preacher has a more public and visible function, the importance of Elders and Deacons cannot be overemphasized. Having godly men who are capable of leadership and serving in the church is essential.

The Bible teaches that there are two offices in the local church: elders and deacons. The elders, also known as overseers, bishops, or pastors in the New Testament, are the primary spiritual leaders of a congregation. Elders teach or preach the Word and shepherd the souls of those entrusted to them. While Deacons, serve over specific tasks or ministries (Eph. 4:11-14; 1 Tim. 3; Titus 1:5-9; Heb. 13:17; 1 Tim 5:17, Acts 6:1-6).

The men who are to serve as Elders and Deacons should live lives that reflect a commitment to God, family, community, and the church. These men should not be seeking power and authority. Instead, they realize that being great in God's eyes comes from faithful service. After all, Jesus came "Not to be served but to serve" Matt 20:28

Here are some general guidelines:

- He must be a lover of God
- He should desire to serve
- He should not be a novice
- He should have a good reputation in and out of the church
- He should have a commitment to the growth of Greenbank church

Of course, this is not an exhaustive list. Instead, something to get you thinking.

I want to ask Greenbank to do a few things in this as we begin this process of looking for our next leaders.

- 1. Pray before any big decision we must ask God to lead us.
- 2. Read scriptures regarding elders and deacons.
- 3. Meditate on the Word deeply reflect on the qualities that scripture teaches regarding church leaders.
- 4. Ask questions- call the elders or me if you have any questions.
