Empty by Wade McKnight

We walked into the empty house, and I do mean empty! Not only was there no furniture, but there was also no flooring, no walls, no ceiling. All had been removed because of water damage. The studs were bare, and you could look through the house and see from one end to the other. From the outside the house looked perfectly normal – on the inside it was nothing but a skeleton.

"Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of dead men's bones and everything unclean. In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but, on the inside, you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness." Matthew 23:27-28

It is not often we see Christ administering such a barrage of harsh and scathing words. When he did, he reserved it for those times when it was, no doubt, deserved. Christ was critical specifically when their action was keeping them, or even worse, others around them, from a relationship with God. That is why he was so harsh on people who acted as if they had the keys to heaven and demanded others to follow their lead. Christ ached for those who were marching to their own destruction and like the Pied Piper, were leading a host of others with them. Christ cried out to those, "You look so good on the outside but on the inside, you are empty!"

Two days later we walked out of that house in Louisiana, although it no longer looked like the same house. It was amazing what a difference sheetrock on those bare studs made to the inside of the house. It was no longer an empty shell; it was a home with walls and a new life.

That is what Christ offers also. That is what his life was all about, offering fullness where there was once only emptiness. No more fake appearances, no more illusions of righteousness. When we realize what Christ offers and let go of our own false conceptions, all that is left is us kneeling at the cross and Christ filling the void that was once inside.
