A city slicker bought a farm and moved into the farmhouse. He went to his new neighbor and asked if he might purchase a milk cow. If we are content to do only a tiny bit, we may end up doing nothing at all. On the other hand, if we will give and give and give of our time, talent, and treasure, God will supply every need and give us additional opportunities to glorify Him and bless other people's lives.
