4 Steps to Achieving Christian Unity by Charles Morris (edited)

Christian unity is a biblical principle that is based on the Holy Spirit's work to bring believers together as one body in Christ. It is essential to understand that, as a Christian, you are united with Christ and every other believer in the world. In Ephesians 4:2-3, Paul calls for unity by urging Christians to be humble, gentle, patient, and bear with one another in love. Here are four biblical steps that can help us achieve Christian unity.

<u>Step 1: Be Completely Humble</u>. Humility means putting the needs of others before our own. It requires us to realize that we are all human, and we all sin. Christians need to humble themselves, realizing that they are not better than anyone else.

<u>Step 2: Be Gentle</u>. Gentleness flows from realizing how completely dependent we are on God. When we understand how gently God has been with us, who have sinned against Him, we can begin to be gentle with other Christians, even those with whom we disagree.

<u>Step 3: Be Patient</u>. Being patient means being quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. It requires self-control and a willingness to put aside our own needs and desires while striving to listen to and understand others.

<u>Step 4: Be Forbearing</u>. Believers are called to bear with one another in love, even those who are too opinionated or who annoy us. Christ said, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." There are no exception clauses here.

Christ set the ultimate example of humility and gentleness, showing us how to love and serve one another. He came down from heaven and humbled himself, even to death on a cross, for our sakes. He is gentle and lowly in heart, and He calls us to follow in His footsteps.

Friends, Christian unity is essential, and in following these four steps we can achieve it. We must continually work to put them into practice in our lives, and we must rely on Christ and the Holy Spirit to help us.
