Practicing the Golden Rule by Andy Sochor

"In everything, therefore, treat people the same way you want them to treat you, for this is the Law and the Prophets" (Matthew 7:12). Most people, religious or not, recognize the "golden rule" – do unto others as you would have them do unto you. This is based upon Jesus' statement in our text above. We know the statement, but how do we put it into practice? Let us consider a few thoughts.

<u>Take the initiative</u>: Show love to others regardless of how they treat you. Turn the other cheek and respond with kindness even when faced with mistreatment or persecution.

<u>Understand the reasons</u>: Obey God's command to love others and recognize the inherent value in each person. All individuals are made in God's image and worthy of love and respect.

<u>Treat others with respect</u>: Put others first, be willing to forgive, strive for peace, and help those in need. Show kindness and generosity to all, especially fellow believers.

<u>Share the truth gently</u>: Teach others as you would want to be taught, with gentleness and humility. Lead them to the truth with grace and respond to each person's needs.

<u>Help others in need</u>: Treat them as you would want to be treated. This includes doing good to all people, especially those in the household of faith, and being like the compassionate Samaritan who helps those in need (Galatians 6:10, Luke 10:30-37, James 2:14-17).

<u>Practice the golden rule by leading others to the truth</u>. Just as we would want someone to correct and teach us, we should teach others with gentleness and humility. This involves speaking with grace and knowing how to respond to each person (2 Timothy 2:24-25, Titus 3:2-3, Matthew 7:1-5, Matthew 7:13-14, Colossians 4:6).

Regardless of how others treat us, we should treat them with love and respect. By practicing the golden rule, we demonstrate our love for others and open ourselves to receiving the same love, mercy, and kindness from the Lord.
