Drawing Near to God in Worship by Domingo Reyes

In the midst of our busy lives, have you ever felt the pull to pause and connect with God in a greater way? That's the essence of authentic worship – a genuine offering of ourselves to our Creator who knows us intimately.

You see, God isn't after elaborate rituals or grand displays. He seeks our hearts. Remember what David wrote in Psalm 51:17? "My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, you God, will not despise." In other words, a humble heart, laid bare before God, is what truly matters. It's in our vulnerability that we find a real connection.

Think about the last time you sang a worship song or said a prayer. Jesus's words in John 4:24 ring true: God wants us to worship Him in spirit and truth. Authentic worship isn't about pretending or as stated earlier, about rituals. Instead, it's about being real and letting God's truth sink deep within to change and connect us to God.

And don't forget the power of surrender. Romans 12:1 paints a vivid picture of offering ourselves as living sacrifices. Surrender paves the way for transformation – letting go of our plans to make space for His.

Next time you're in that quiet moment, think of Psalm 95:6. It's an invitation: "Come, let's bow down in worship." Let's infuse our worship with authenticity, and dialogue with the One who knows us best. It's in authenticity that we draw nearer to the heart of God.
