

An Empty Chair by Wayne Burger

In the Bible, King David's empty seat at King Saul's feast signified his absence (1 Samuel 20:18, 24-27). Jonathan explained David's vacant chair to his father Saul (1 Samuel 20:29). Though David had good reasons to miss the feast, his chair being empty meant passing up a chance to dine with the king. This illustrates that our own empty seats at the Lord's table, whether in worship or Bible study, send a message.

When we or our children skip Bible classes on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights, teachers have prepared lessons but chairs sit empty. Though life is busy, these absences leave a vacuum in our spiritual lives and our children's. Studies show children tend to attend even less than parents who only occasionally attend. But children are more likely to be dedicated church members as adults when their parents actively participated.

So, what do our empty chairs say? They communicate: something else is more important than studying God's Word; the messages shared are not relevant to life; our presence is not needed to encourage others; we don't appreciate the teacher's preparation efforts. Conversely, occupied chairs say positive things. The chair will speak whether occupied or empty.

What will your chair say this Wednesday evening or Sunday? Will it signify your commitment to spiritual growth, or your apathy? Our chairs impact our lives and our children's. Let us be found studying God's Word together whenever possible, rather than leaving empty seats.
