Fear Not When All Feels Lost by Chuck Swindoll (edited)

God is in charge. He is over everything. He is sovereign, ruling graciously and powerfully from Heaven in perfect wisdom, love, and grace (see Psalm 11). Whatever you face, adverse or delightful, your life is about God—His will, His way.

We easily lose our theological moorings when we insist on living horizontally. When we do, adversity causes us to drift from what we truly believe. How much better to respond with faith, submitting to God's sovereign will and yielding to His purposes in both giving and taking away.

After all, that's His sovereign right. God doesn't exist to make us healthy and happy but to glorify His name. We are the channel for that glory. T. S. Eliot puts it this way:

"To believe in the supernatural is not simply to believe that after living a successful, material, and fairly virtuous life here one will continue to exist in the best possible substitute for this world... it is to believe that the supernatural is the greatest reality here and now."

Reread that profound statement. Faith is not what you purchase or produce but knowing your heavenly Father works for His glory and your good, molding you into the image of His Son, Jesus. If it takes loss to gain that perspective, embrace it. Abandon what you've counted on if it realigns your life vertically. It is all about God, who gives and takes away.

Job realized that the most important thing is in the supernatural, not the natural. Real living is eternal. Real perspective is understanding the unseen. Real maturity is living by intangibles.

Consider Paul's words from Colossians 3:1-4. That's a foundation for a vertical perspective.

Learn and accept that God is in control, sovereign, and divinely guiding your life. God is incomprehensibly great—omniscient, omnipotent, omnipresent, eternal, ageless, timeless, good, gracious, loving, and just. He's always right, even when you feel wronged.
