Love the Church Like Christ Does by D. Benge

In today's world, it's easy to become disillusioned with the church. Scandals and failings often dominate the headlines, casting the church in a negative light. However, we must ask ourselves: Does Jesus see the church in the same way?

John Gill, an eighteenth-century pastor, provides a beautiful insight. He interprets the words of Song of Solomon 1:15, "You are beautiful, my love," as Jesus speaking to His church. Despite its flaws and sins, Jesus sees His church as beautiful. He looks at His bride through a lens of love, not disdain.

The church's beauty comes from reflecting God's glory. This glory, seen in the Bible through events like Moses witnessing God's splendor, is ultimately displayed in Jesus Christ. Jesus, the image of God's beauty, extends this beauty to His church. The church is a gift from God to His Son, chosen to reflect divine love.

Jesus also sees the church through the sacrifice of His cross. The church's beauty isn't inherent; it comes from being washed clean by Jesus' blood. This redemption makes the church beautiful in Jesus' eyes.

Finally, the church's mission to spread the gospel adds to its beauty. Jesus commissioned the church to share the good news, making it a vessel of His love and salvation.

Jesus doesn't scorn His church. Instead, He cherishes it as His beloved bride, awaiting the day He will welcome her into His eternal presence. Let us, too, see the church through Jesus' loving eyes and proclaim, "You are beautiful, my love."
