Our Call to Make Disciples By Barry Davis

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." — Matthew 28:19-20

In these final words of Jesus before His ascension, He gives His followers a clear and powerful mission: to go and make disciples of all nations. This is the Great Commission, a call to every believer to spread the gospel and teach others about the life-transforming power of Jesus Christ.

Notice that Jesus didn't limit this command to a specific group or region—He calls us to reach all nations, reflecting the inclusive, global scope of the gospel. The command involves both baptizing, symbolizing initiation into the faith, and teaching, which helps believers grow in their knowledge and obedience to Christ's commands.

But we're not called to fulfill this mission alone. Jesus promises His presence with us, "to the very end of the age." This assurance gives us confidence and strength to go into the world, knowing that He walks with us every step of the way.

Life Application:

Ask God to show you where He is calling you to make disciples. Whether it's in your home, workplace, or across the globe, take steps to share the gospel and invest in others' spiritual growth.

Prayer Points:

- 1. Lord, give me a heart for the lost and a desire to share Your gospel with all nations.
- 2. **Help me to teach others faithfully**, leading them to deeper obedience to You.
- 3. **Thank You for Your promise** to always be with me as I follow Your command.
