Imagine a life without gratitude—a world where blessings go unnoticed, joy is fleeting, and peace is out of reach. Thanksgiving changes everything. It's a powerful act that transforms hearts and draws us closer to God, the ultimate source of every good gift. Throughout the Bible, thanksgiving is a recurring theme. The Old Testament resounds with Israel's praises for God's mercy and deliverance. In the New Testament, Jesus gave thanks before feeding the 5,000 (Luke 9:16) and at the Last Supper (1 Cor. 11:24), modeling gratitude as a vital part of prayer.

As the holiday approaches, consider these thoughts on giving thanks:

• **Motive**: True thanksgiving stems from pure gratitude. Unlike other prayers, thanksgiving is less likely to be influenced by selfish motives. It focuses solely on God's blessings and our appreciation of them.

• **Knowledgeable**: Gratitude requires reflection on past blessings, a practice often overshadowed by our culture's focus on the future. Thanksgiving is about looking back and acknowledging God's goodness in our lives.

• **Comprehensive**: While the holiday prompts thanks for a meal, our gratitude should encompass family, friends, shelter, work, and countless other blessings. The Pilgrims, dependent on God's providence, thanked Him in both scarcity and abundance.

As Thanksgiving Day approaches, reflect on your blessings and thank God for His provision and care.
