The Power of Quiet Faith by Charles Stanley

In a world that celebrates great achievements and public success, it's easy to forget that God often works in the quiet places. When Elijah stood on the mountain, I waited to hear God in the wind, the earthquake, or the fire. But God spoke in a gentle whisper (1 Kings 19:11-12).

Faith isn't always about dramatic moments—it's about steady trust. Consider Noah, who built an ark for decades before the first drop of rain. Or Mary, who simply said, "Let it be to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38) and carried the Savior of the world. Their faith wasn't just in words; it was in daily obedience, even when the results weren't immediate.

God still speaks in the quiet moments of our lives. When we open His Word, when we pray in the stillness, when we choose to trust instead of fear—these are acts of faith that shape our walk with Him.

You may not see instant results. You may wonder if your small acts of obedience matter. But God is faithful. He sees every prayer, every moment of trust, and every quiet step forward.

So today, take a deep breath and listen to His whisper. He is nearby, working in ways you may not see, but you can always trust.
