A Kingdom Mindset: Keeping Our Mission Clear

It's easy to get caught up in the pursuit of success—chasing money, comfort, and the things the world tells us we need. But as Christians, we're called to live differently. Jesus said in Matthew 6:33, "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." Our priority isn't building our kingdom—it's building His.

The world pushes us to focus on wealth, status, and temporary pleasure. But a kingdom mindset shifts our perspective from the temporary to the eternal. Paul reminds us in Romans 12:2, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." That renewal changes how we think and live. Instead of following the world's patterns, we follow Christ's example—putting spiritual things first.

Living with a kingdom mindset isn't just about personal growth—it's about mission. 2 Corinthians 5:20 says we are ambassadors for Christ. That means we represent Him wherever we go. Our words, our actions, and how we treat people should point them back to Jesus.

At the end of the day, this world is not our home (Philippians 3:20). If we lose sight of that, we'll start chasing things that don't last. But when we keep our eyes on the kingdom, we stay focused on what truly matters: glorifying God, sharing the gospel, and living with purpose.
