Hey Church Family,

Let’s talk about something real for a second—taking care of yourself. I know, some of us grew up thinking that was selfish. Like if you’re not constantly doing for others, you’re not being Christ-like. But that’s not what Jesus taught.

Remember when He said, “Love your neighbor as yourself” (Matt. 22:39)? That last part—as yourself—gets skipped over way too often. He didn’t say, “Love your neighbor instead of yourself.” He assumed we’d already know how to treat ourselves with care and then extend that same grace outward.

And Jesus practiced what He preached. He pulled away from the noise. He rested. He prayed alone. He didn’t heal every single person in every town. He didn’t say yes to every demand. He rested because He knew the mission was big, and you can’t do big things on an empty tank.
