

# When God Feels Silent by J. Miller

There's something unsettling about praying and hearing... nothing.

You pour out your heart. You ask for clarity, healing, peace—*anything*. But instead of answers, you're met with silence. No sign. No breakthrough. Just waiting. And it can feel like God's a million miles away.

But silence isn't absence.

God has a long history of going quiet—not because He doesn't care, but because He's doing something deeper. Think of Job. He lost everything, and for much of his suffering, God didn't say a word. Even Jesus, in His darkest moment on the cross, cried out, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46). Even the Son felt it.

The truth is, silence can be a sacred space. It's often where trust is tested and faith is refined. Where we learn to follow not because everything makes sense, but because God is still good.

Isaiah 30:18 says, "The Lord longs to be gracious to you... blessed are all who wait for Him."

If you're in one of those quiet seasons—don't give up. Don't walk away just because you can't hear Him right now. God's not done. He's not absent. He's just working in ways you can't see yet.

Stay faithful in the silence. The voice is coming.
