Faith in the Slow Seasons by Domingo Reyes

We all love spiritual mountaintops—those seasons where prayers are answered, attendance is strong, and it feels like the Spirit is moving in every direction.

But what about the slow seasons?

What about the times when the harvest is thin, energy is low, and it feels like we're just waiting—for revival, for clarity, for hope?

In these moments, we need to remember: God is just as present in the silence as He is in the shout.
