Leaning on God by Domingo Reyes

Life has a way of showing us how fragile we really are. Some seasons bring sudden storms — a phone call that changes everything, a diagnosis, or a loss we never saw coming. Other times, it's a slow weight we carry day after day. In both moments, we are faced with a choice: Will we lean on ourselves, or will we lean on God?

Scripture calls us to put our full weight on Him: "Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight" (Proverbs 3:5–6). Leaning means relying completely. When we lean on our own understanding, we falter. But when we lean on God, His strength holds us up.

We can trust Him because He is faithful — "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5). He knows what lies ahead (Isaiah 46:10), and He cares for us deeply — "Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7).

So how do we lean on Him?

- **Pray honestly** tell Him your fears, hopes, and struggles.
- **Rest in His Word** fill your mind with His promises.
- **Lean together** bear each other's burdens (Galatians 6:2).

When life feels heavy, remember: God never asked you to carry it alone. The same arms that stretched out on the cross are the arms that hold you now. Lean fully. Trust deeply. Rest completely in Him.
