The Power of Encouragement - D. Reyes

Hebrews 10:24–25 urges us, "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another..."

Encouragement might seem like a small act, but its impact can be eternal. A kind word can lift a weary heart. A listening ear can restore hope. A simple note, call, or prayer can remind someone they are not forgotten.

In the early church, believers faced persecution, uncertainty, and hardship. Yet one of the reasons they remained strong was because they intentionally encouraged each other. Barnabas, whose name means "Son of Encouragement," became known for building others up—helping believers grow in faith and boldness.

In our busy lives, it's easy to assume someone else will do the encouraging. But God calls each of us to take that role seriously. We never know when a single word of kindness might be the very thing God uses to strengthen a brother or sister in Christ.

Encouragement also flows both ways—when we pour into others, we often find our own spirits lifted. Proverbs 11:25 reminds us, "Whoever refreshes others will be refreshed."

This week, be intentional about reaching out to someone in the congregation—maybe someone who's been absent, a young person facing big decisions, or a senior who may feel isolated. A simple act of encouragement could be the spark that renews their faith.
